Saturday, July 25, 2026 – Hog and Beef Cattle Jackpot Shows

- 6:00 am Hogs and Cattle begin to arrive
- 7:00 am Registration Begins and Scales Open
- 8:30 am Scales Close for Hogs
- 9:30 am Hog Jackpot Show (starting with Senior Showmanship)
- 10:30 am Scales Close for Cattle
- 12:30 pm Cattle Jackpot Show (starting with Senior Showmanship)

Rules and Regulations

1. Youth exhibitors only.
2. Exhibitors must be 21 years or younger as of September 30, 2026.
3. Entries: Day of show only. No pre-entries.
4. Entry fees:

Livestock - **\$40**

\$20 if animal is also being exhibited in the Augusta County Fair Open Show
Showmanship - **\$10**

5. Entries can only be shown once - either shown in a Breeding Class or a Market Class.
6. Jackpot Shows will start with Showmanship, then Breeding classes, then Market classes.
7. Each exhibitor will receive 3 passes for Saturday only.
8. Health papers are only required on "out of state" livestock entered in the Jackpot Shows and must be checked before unloading.
9. Stalling and Pen space may be limited; you may show off your trailer if needed.
10. Wash rack space is limited, plan accordingly.
11. Any unethical behavior will be cause for dismissal from the fairgrounds.

12. Exhibitors are responsible to be at the entry gate when a class goes into the show ring; when entry gate closes you are out.
13. Failure to clean stalls, tack/fitting areas and areas around trailers will result in forfeiture of premiums.
14. Exhibitors, parents, and fitters must abide by 4-H and FFA Code of Conduct.
15. Classes will be shown by breeds; must have 5 entries or more or will be entered as All Other Breeds.
16. The Barn Committee will remove any livestock that is unsafe or deemed a health issue by our fair veterinarians, regardless of health paper status.
