Required for all ages...

GOWN – All age groups will model a gown. Contestants in Baby – Young may wear a long or short gown, all other age groups must wear a long gown. Gown should be age appropriate, showing your personality and flattering to you.

Optional for all ages...

PHOTOGENIC – Photos should be age appropriate and may be natural or slightly retouched. Pictures may be black & white or color and should be no larger than 8x10 in size. Headshots are recommended, without distractions. Photos should reflect the contestant's photogenic potential. **Submit photos at registration** and enter as many as you like. If multiple photos are entered, the photo with the highest score will be used for the age division award.

Preteen Miss 10-12, Junior Miss 13-15, Miss 16-22 and Mrs. age divisions will also have Interview on Friday evening and Casual Wear on Saturday!

Preteen, Junior, Miss and Mrs. age divisions...

INTERVIEW – Contestants should dress professionally; attire may be a dress, pantsuit, or business suit. Contestants will have a private four minute interview with the judge's panel. Interview will give the judges an opportunity to get to know the contestant. Contestants should showcase their ability to interact with the public as a titleholder. **Contestants should submit a fact sheet with additional information with their entry form.** Interviews will be held on Friday evening, starting at 4:00PM. Exact location and interview times will be sent the week of the pageant.

CASUAL WEAR – Casual wear should be a stylish outfit out of the closet, age appropriate, fashionable, showing contestants style and personality (no jeans or sweats). **This will be modeled first on pageant day!**

OFFICIAL RULES and REGULATIONS (please read completely)

1. **This pageant is open to anyone regardless of residency, except for Miss 16-22 years!**
2. **Miss 16-22 year old contestants only** must reside or attend school in Augusta County or any of our surrounding counties! Augusta County, Staunton or Waynesboro; Rockingham County or Harrisonburg; Rockbridge County, Lexington or Buena Vista; Albemarle County or Charlottesville; Highland County; Nelson County or Bath County.
3. Valid certification of age or residency may be required.
4. Original entry form must be submitted.
5. **There are absolutely NO REFUNDS REGARDLESS OF THE REASON!**
6. The decision of the judges is final.
7. This pageant does not issue individual score sheets.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by contestants, parents or others in attendance. Please be aware that any rude or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification and dismissal from the pageant.
9. Contestants must have never been married nor had children, with the exception of the Mrs. division.
10. Parents have the right to move their daughter up one age division if she is within six months of her birthday, making her eligible for that group.
11. **Pageant winners may not enter another fair pageant during her year as Miss Augusta County Fair.**
12. Previous winners may compete again after they sit out one year or move up to the next age division. Miss division winners may compete again for the title, but they must sit out one year and meet all other requirements.
13. **Miss Augusta County Fair will receive a \$1000 scholarship** in lieu of attending the VAF pageant. This pageant does not advance to the VAF state pageant! Scholarship paid to the source of higher education after crowning her successor.
14. **Preteen Miss, Junior Miss, Miss and Mrs. Queens will be required to sign a contract with the fair board outlining our expectations for the year. They will be required to be available daily during fair week for various functions and responsibilities. If they are unable to fulfill their duties and responsibilities, the first runners-up will become Queen.**
15. Preteen Miss, Junior Miss, Miss and Mrs. contestants will have a private four-minute interview with the judges on Friday evening. Exact location and times will be sent in advance!
16. Dressing rooms open by 9:00AM on the day of the pageant. Please bring extension cords if needed!
17. **Preteen Miss, Junior Miss, Miss and Mrs. Queens will be required to do 25 hours of community service in direct support and benefit of the Augusta County Fair throughout her year of service.**

19. All entries/attendees release Kirk Propst, emcees, staff, judges, Augusta Expo and the Augusta County Fair from any responsibility or liability due to the loss of personal property, illness, stolen/lost items or accident that may occur before, during or after this pageant.
